Community Gateway Association (CGA) have replaced the broken slabs on Grantham Walk making it look a lot better. The PCC have been cutting back in The Avenue and other areas around Tanterton, this includes the corner at Sheraton and the removal of the foliage from here has allowed the street light to shine through. Paths have been edged and Mayfield Avenue ginnel looks significantly better and Tanterton shop area is also being tackled. We also have a Challenge group who have provided over 200 hours of their time to help with the Mayfield ginnel clearance. Dog Fouling

Improvements in the village green were identified in the Community Questionnaire as a priority. Your neighbourhood Council (NC) together with Preston City Councillors are looking into the cost and timescale of reconstructing the drainage of at least one football pitch.
