

Ingol and Tanterton PACT meeting July 2015

THEFT OF PROPERTY FROM A BUS ON INGOL. THE AGGRIEVED LEFT HIS SHOPPING BAG ON THE BUS BY MISTAKE. BY THE TIME THE BUS GOT TO THE DEPOT THE PROPERTY HAD GONE. RUCKSACK/FOOD/SMALL AMOUNT OF MONEY STOLEN

THE HILCREST GARAGE ON TAG LANE HAS HAD PROPERTY STOLEN FROM IT IN THE EARLY HOURS. SOMEBODY HAS APPROACHED A LOCKED CAGE CONTAINING VARIOUS GAS CANNISTERS AND STOLEN THEM, VALUED AT £250. UNFORTUNATELY CCTV HAS NOT COVERED THE INCIDENT

AN UNKNOWN OFFENDER ON NEWLYN PLACE HAS POURED RED PAINT OVER A CAR. ALL HOUSE TO HOUSE ENQUIRIES HAVE BEEN CARRIED OUT NEGATIVE AND NO CCTV IN AREA. SUSPECTS A NEIGHBOUR IS INVOLVED BUT NO EVIDENCE. GATEWAY HOUSING ALSO INFORMED

A MALE ON NEW ROUGH HEY WAS ARRESTED FOR BEING IN POSSESSION OF A SMALL AMOUNT OF HEROINE. THE MALE WAS FROM THE ASHTON AREA AND HAS SINCE BEEN CHARGED FOR THE OFFENCE

THE REAR WINDSCREEN OF A VEHICLE PARKED ON DUNBAR ROAD WAS SMASHED IN THE EARLY HOURS. NO LINES OF ENQUIRY.

ON THE AVENUE, OVERNIGHT THE REAR WINDOW OF A FORD TRANSIT WAS SMASHED AND A STIHL SAW AND BLOW TORCH AND GAS BOTTLE WERE STOLEN. NO CCTV COVERING THE AREA AND NO FORENSICS

A YOUNG MALE ON A PUSH BIKE HAS APPROACHED AN INSECURE RENAULT MEGANE NEAR INGOL CANAL . HE HAS ENTERED THE VEHICLE AND TAKEN A SAT NAV, A JACKET AND A MOBILE PHONE. HE WAS DISTURBED BY THE OWNER AND MADE OFF ON HIS BIKE. THE TWO THEN ENGAGED IN A SCUFFLE WHEREBY THE AGGRIEVED MANAGED TO GET SOME OF HIS ITEMS BACK

ON COTTAM LANE SOMEBODY HAS FORCED THE LOCK FROM A SHED MANAGING TO GAIN ACCESS TO A LARGE FREEZER. ONCE INSIDE AROUND £400 OF FROZEN MEAT WAS STOLEN.

AN ADDRESS ON TURNFIELD HAS HAD ITS REAR DOOR FORCED AND HAD LOTS OF FISHING TACKLE STOLEN AS WELL AS A TV. A MALE FROM ASHTON WAS CAUGHT INSIDE THE ADDRESS BY POLICE. HE WAS SUBSEQUENTLY CHARGED WITH BURGLARY.

A BUS WINDOW WAS SMASHED ON TAG LANE. A GROUP WERE IN THE AREA AT THE TIME BUT THE ACTUAL OFFENDERS MADE OFF. 2 NAMES OF LOCAL LADS HAVE BEEN GIVEN AND ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE FOR THEM TO BOTH COME IN AND BE INTERVIEWED. STILL AWAITING CCTV TO BE DOWNLOADED FROM THE BUS ITSELF TO PROVE WHICH ONE THREW THE ROCK WHICH SMASHED THE WINDOW

A VEHICLE WAS KEYED ON REDCAR AVENUE. THIS IS SUSPECTED TO BE A NEIGHBOUR DISPUTE INVOLVING A LOCAL MALE BUT NO EVIDENCE TO BACK THIS UP AS YET

DAMAGE HAS BEEN CAUSED AT THE NISA STORE. A GROUP OF LOCALS HAVE BEGUN LIFTING UP THE LOOSE FLAGGED AREA OUTSIDE AND THROWN BITS OF RUBBLE AT THE SHOP WINDOWS. POLICE ARE AWAITING SPEAKING TO MANAGER WHO MAY HAVE CCTV IDENTIFYING THE YOUTHS INVOLVED
